: Bursa Malaysia's Transition to CDS eStatements – Effective 25 August 2025

Please be informed that Bursa Malaysia Depository Sdn Bhd will transition to electronic communications for all Central Depository System (CDS) account statements, notices, and related correspondences starting from 25 August 2025.

This initiative is part of Bursa Malaysia's commitment to Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) principles, aiming to reduce paper usage, lower carbon emissions, and improve the security, efficiency, and accessibility of investor communications.

Benefits of eStatement:

- Timely and secure delivery of CDS statements and notices directly to clients registered email.
- Completely free of charge.
- Reduced risk of missed correspondences.
- Easy storage and organization of digital records.

Clients may sign up for eStatements through any of the following methods:

- 1. MyBURSA Portal
- 2. Self-registration via Bursa Malaysia website
- 3. Bursa Anywhere mobile app (available on Apple App Store & Google Play)
- 4. Via ADA/stockbroking firm submission of registration form CDS Account Form (FMN070)
- 5. In-person at the Bursa Assist Help Centre

However, certain specified depositors are eligible for hard copy statements, including specified depositors (aged 65 and older, those with disabilities, those in areas with limited internet access, or those with difficulty accessing eStatements) and those who pay an annual subscription fee to Bursa Malaysia.

Specified Depositors:

- Senior Age: Depositors aged 65 and older (70 and older as of 2025 who currently receive hardcopy statements will continue to do so automatically, while those 65-69 will need to request them from Bursa Malaysia).
- Disability: Depositors with disabilities.
- Limited Internet Access: Depositors residing in areas with limited or poor internet connectivity.
- Difficulty Accessing eStatements: Other depositors who, as determined by Bursa Depository, have difficulty accessing eStatements.
- Subscribers: Depositors who pay an annual subscription fee for hard copy statements.

Bursa Malaysia encourages all clients to transition to eStatements for a more secure and sustainable investing experience.
